- Obey Instructions of Stewards and Safety Officers in the Showgrounds
- Members of the public are requested to take reasonable precautions to avoid accidents

- Trade Exhibitors must have Safety Statements
- Members of the public with exhibits for dog show / leisure must ensure all dogs are on lead at all times
- All accidents must be reported immediately on the day to the Safety Officer

The Irish Shows Association would advise all animal owners who have their animals insured to have the Insurance cover extended to cover them while showing animals at shows. The reason for us giving you this advice is that should your animal injure somebody / damage another property and it is established that your animal was out of control at that time, you may be held responsible or partly responsible for any injury /damage caused and responsible for payment /part of any settlement reached.

Conditions Governing Cup Competitions

- Winners of Cups in 2022 must give an undertaking to the Committee that the Cups will be returned to the Secretary at least 10 days prior to the date of the succeeding show and in same condition as when issued.

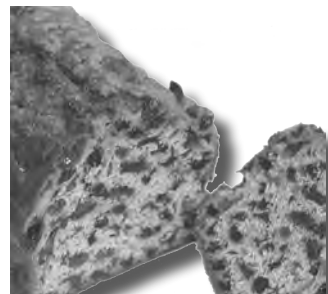

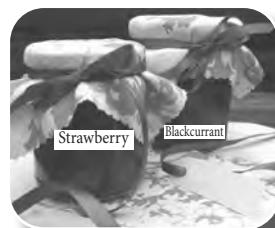
